1. Installation and activation

1. Create „wsp“ folder in your C:\, and copy the solution wsp in there so the path looks like this
C:\wsp\SPDisplaySiteCollectionChanges.wsp

2. Deploy the wsp file to the server using the given **example** commands (Sharepoint Shell) - >
you'll have to change purple parts according to your needs

- `Add-SPSolution -LiteralPath
C:\wsp\SPDisplaySiteCollectionChanges.wsp;`

3. Install the solution to the server

- `Install-SPSolution -Identity SPDisplaySiteCollectionChanges.wsp -
gacdeployment;`

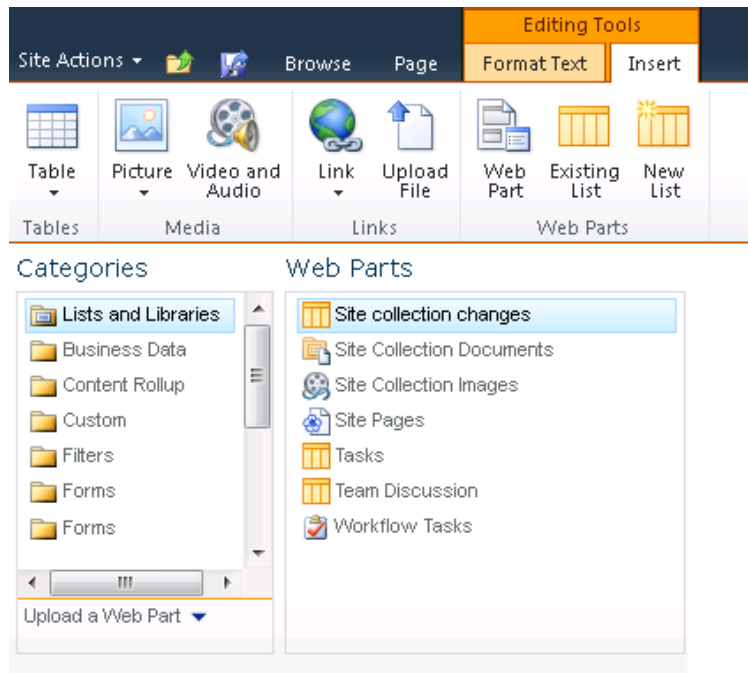
4. Activate Feature on desired site collection (**be carefull to change http to https if you are using it**)

- `Enable-SPFeature -Identity
"SPDisplaySiteCollectionChanges_SPDisplaySiteCollectionChangesFeature
" -url "http://intranet.contoso.com"`

5. Open site collection features and activate SPDisplaySiteCollectionChanges feature

2. Usage and settings

Edit your site on which you want Display site collection changes. Click Add a WebPart, choose *Lists and Libraries*, „Site collection changes“ list.



After that, select the list on the site where you added webpart, edit list permissions -> allow all people who should be allowed to see the list to „view only“ so they cannot modify the items.

You can also edit your webpart and set its toolbar type to „no toolbar“ if you don't want to have „add new item“ link below the list.

To limit items per page which will be shown you can modify the list view.

3. Timer job settings

In your central administration, under timer job list you can find: *SP Display Site Collection Changes Timer Job*

You can adjust timer job run schedule according to your needs. Default is set to run every 30 minutes.

4. Uninstallation

To uninstall the solution use the following commands in Sharepoint shell:

- `Disable-SPFeature -Identity "SPDisplaySiteCollectionChanges_SPDisplaySiteCollectionChangesFeature" -url "http://intranet.contoso.com/"`
- `uninstall-spsolution -identity SPDisplaySiteCollectionChanges.wsp;`
- WAIT APPROX. 30 seconds for command to finish and then type:
- `Remove-SPSolution SPDisplaySiteCollectionChanges.wsp;`
